



Temporary Heat Application

Mid-American may be authorized to set the meter and turn on the gas riser to provide temporary heat. For gas meter activation, the **licensed contractor responsible** for the gas pipe installation shall connect to the meter outlet valve with **galvanized pipe** and pressure test the gas piping system in the structure. The completed affidavit together with the normal visual inspection by the City will be required before Mid-American Energy is authorized to unlock and turn on the riser valve.

All requirements for temporary heat must be met prior to the request for an inspection. If not met, there will be a \$50 re-inspection fee assessed for each inspection that does not pass.

Occupancy of the structure is strictly prohibited. Occupancy shall only be allowed once the Certificate of Occupancy has been obtained.
